CONDITIONS FOR EXHIBITING

1. All entry forms must be received by Friday July 2nd, 2010. Entry forms should be mailed to Garry Coombes 8 Yappo Road ALDGATE 5154, or emailed (glcjm05@bigpond.net.au). Early receipt of entries will help us with our preparation. **DO NOT SEND ENTRY FEES AT THIS STAGE.**
2. An entry fee of \$2 per item will be charged. Exhibitors will be permitted to submit up to 8 entries.
3. All exhibits must be delivered to the Wayville Pavilion at the Adelaide Showgrounds between 1pm and 3pm on Wednesday July 14th. All exhibits must be accompanied by the **ENTRY FEE** and by a **WRITTEN DESCRIPTOR**. (see overleaf). The descriptor must be trimmed to size (180 x130mm). It should follow the format provided and be in Times New Roman in 18 pt. for consistency amongst all exhibits.
4. Any sales of work will be made per the exhibitor and not through the Woodgroup.
5. The Organising Committee reserves the right to exclude any entry from the Exhibition. Reasons for any exclusion will be given and entry fees refunded.
6. Under normal conditions all exhibits will remain on display for the duration of the Exhibition.
7. Expenses incurred in the delivery and return of exhibits are the responsibility of exhibitors.
8. Whilst the Exhibition will be supervised, all items for exhibition are displayed and stored at exhibitor's risk. If entrants wish to insure their exhibit against theft or damage, it is their responsibility to take out the relevant insurance cover.
9. Woodgroup SA reserves the right to use any exhibit for publicity by any media for the duration of the Exhibition and for any review of the Exhibition
10. Authority for an agent to collect items must be in writing.
11. With the exception of very large or awkward pieces, all entries must be delivered in a bubble wrap envelope, approximately the size of the exhibit. The committee will number these according to the catalogue, and any unsold work will be returned in its envelope. Similarly, any sold work will be given to the purchaser in its envelope.
12. Unsold exhibits are to be collected from the Wayville Pavilion between 5pm and 6pm on Sunday July 18th, or between 9am and 10am on Monday July 19th or by other prior written arrangements.
13. Sold items may be collected by the purchaser after 4pm on Sunday July 18th.
14. All exhibitors are requested to be rostered for at least one supervision timeslot.
15. The minimum price for any exhibit for sale is \$50

GENERAL INFORMATION

Much of the success of past exhibitions has been due to the 'Descriptors' which have accompanied exhibits. These have created much interest for viewers who spend a great deal of time reading them. However typing these has been the greatest task in mounting exhibitions. Therefore we are again seeking assistance from exhibitors in organising their own descriptors. (see reverse side).

As in other years, we seek donations of 15% from successful exhibitors to help to defray the cost of mounting this exhibition.
